



Data protection information regarding the production, processing and use of image and/or video recordings according to GDPR

According to the GDPR, every person affected must be comprehensively informed in accordance with Art. 13 GDPR as soon as image and video recordings of him/her are collected, stored, passed on etc.

Legal basis of the processing

The processing of images and/or videos (collection, storage, processing and transfer to third parties) is based on the express consent of the person concerned or of the person with custody of the person concerned (in the case of persons up to 16 years of age), which is granted in accordance with Art. 6 para. 1 letter a GDPR.

Addressee of the image or video data sets or purpose of processing:

The recorded image and/or video data sets are used for research and teaching at the Karlsruhe University of Applied Sciences.

Addressee	Purpose to be fulfilled (info necessary!)
<i>Scientific print media, scientific digital media, scientific servers, scientific and academic institutions</i>	Test and benchmark data sets for scientific and academic purposes after approval of a license agreement (incl. data protection agreement)

Duration of storage of personal data (at least 10 years):

Image and video data may be processed and used for the purpose of scientific research at Karlsruhe University of Applied Sciences. I can revoke my agreement at any stage.

Right of withdrawal with consent:

The consent to process the image and/or video files can be revoked at any time. The legality of the data processing carried out since the consent was given is not affected by a revocation. Deletion in scientific papers already published at the time of revocation can of course not be carried out.

Rights of data subjects:

According to the EU GDPR you are entitled to the following important rights of data subjects:

- a) **Information:** If your personal data is processed, you have the right, in accordance with Art. 15 GDPR, to receive information about the personal data stored about you.
- b) **Correction:** Should incorrect personal data be stored and processed, you are entitled to correction in accordance with Art. 16 GDPR.
- c) **Revocation or deletion:** A revocation of the processing, a restriction of the processing or a deletion of the data can be obtained if the legal requirements according to Art. 17, 18, 21 GDPR are met.

Contact person in case of revocation or implementation of the rights of the persons concerned:

Should you make use of the rights listed above, the person responsible will check whether the legal requirements for this are fulfilled and inform you promptly about the further procedure.
